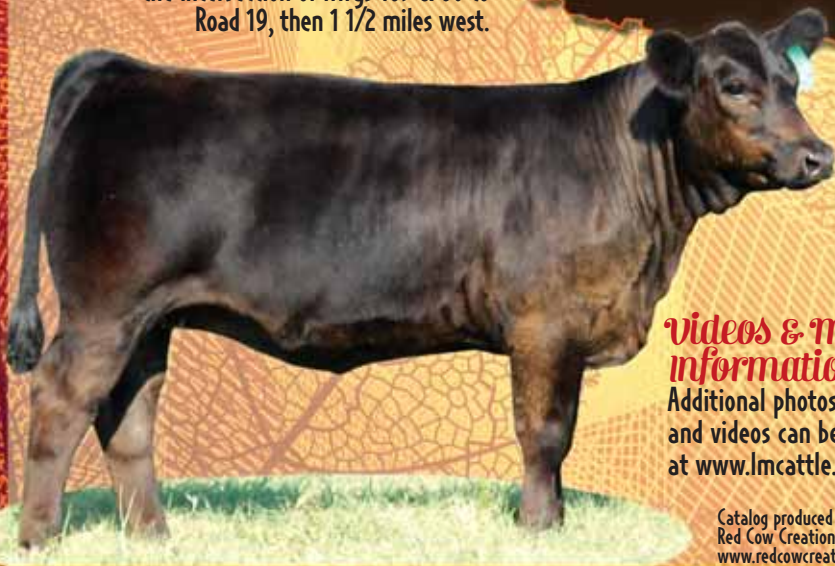

All of our heifers were BVD-PI tested earlier this year. The results were the entire head was negative.

Sale Terms & Information

Any changes from information of any kind in this catalog will be announced from the auction block, and such announcements shall take precedence. The auctioneer will settle any dispute as to bids, and his decision on such matters shall be final. Each animal will be at the purchaser's risk as soon as sold, but it shall be the obligation of the seller to see that his animals are fed and cared for free of charge until the expiration of 48 hours following the sale.

TERMS OF THE SALE ARE CASH. Settlement is to be made immediately following completion of the sale before movement of the animals from the facility. All checks shall be payable to LM Cattle. All registered animals will be transferred to the buyers at the seller's expense. Each buyer should provide the sale clerk, at time of settlement, the proper name and address to make the transfer.

All persons attending this sale do so at their own risk. Neither LM Cattle, the Sale Committee, nor any other person connected with the management of the sale assumes liability, legal or otherwise, for the safety of the building or premises or for the behavior of the animals.

All bred females will be examined by a competent veterinarian who will call heifers bred at best determined date. Buyer will use provided information to determine calf sire. In respect to AI dates, they are not unconditionally guaranteed as such, other than they are pregnant. The buyer has within 21 days following the sale to re-pregnancy test their purchase(s). If any animals are found open within those 21 days, the purchaser must notify LM Cattle at once and a replacement will be provided if available, or a credit equal to the animal's purchase price minus salvage value will be issued for the replacement of the animal. This guarantee does not cover illness or death to the

animal. LM Cattle reserves the right to one flush of any LM Cattle female in the Pick of the Patch Sale. The flush will be at LM Cattle's expense and at the new owner's convenience.

Incentive Program

LM Cattle has developed an incentive program in appreciation to their valued customers. Any animal purchased by a junior exhibitor from LM Cattle in the 2011 Pick of the Patch Sale will be eligible. Consigned cattle are not participants of the program.

- If the purchased animal is a Breed Champion Steer or Heifer at a local/county level the purchaser will receive a \$100 credit toward the purchase of an LM calf in the annual fall production sale.

- If the purchased animal is Grand Champion Steer or Heifer at the local/county level the purchaser will receive a \$200 credit toward the purchase of an LM calf in the annual fall production sale.

- If the purchased animal is a Breed Champion Steer or Heifer at a district, state or regional show the purchaser will receive a \$250 credit toward the purchase of an LM calf in the annual fall production sale.

- If the purchased animal is selected Grand Champion Steer or Heifer at a district, state or regional show the purchaser will receive a \$350 credit toward the purchase of an LM calf in the annual fall production sale.

Each animal is only eligible for one awarded credit and proper documentation of the award, including a backdrop picture at the show of the winning animal, must be presented to LM Cattle prior to the 2012 sale. Awarded credit must be used at the first following fall production sale of the animals' winnings.
